

FLEA TRAP CAPTURE PADS

Effective - Safe - Easy to Use
Non-toxic - Environmentally Friendly



Directions

- Peel the Capture Pad
- Place Pad in Trap - Sticky Side Up
- Plug in the Trap

Activate capture pad by pulling off the brown release paper. Remove the screen from the trap and insert the pad Sticky Side Up! Replace the protective screen over the capture pad. Place your Flea Trap on the floor and plug it into a regular electrical outlet.

In case of contact, remove the glue with vegetable oil.

BEST PLACES FOR THE FLEA TRAP

Put the Flea Trap near areas in your house where fleas are present, such as where pets sleep, rest, eat or walk on a regular basis. Put the Flea Trap where fleas can see the light. Flea Traps placed under furniture can be very effective, but the light should not be hidden by skirting around the furniture. Using more than one Flea Trap will give better coverage and best results. **Leave the Flea Trap on ALL the time for best effects.** This is a permanent system that can remove fleas for many years if well maintained.

FOR OTHER STYLE TRAPS

For round or square-style flea traps with flat bottoms, simply place 1 or 2 capture pads in the base of the trap. For wall-mounted flea traps, remove the old sticky pad and place the new capture pad in the same place. For traps that use little plastic tray holders, fold over 1/4" of the long side of the capture pad (glue up) and, holding onto the folded edge, slide the capture pad into the space where the tray goes.

FLEA TRAP FACTS

The FLEA TRAP attracts and captures adult fleas. Use it as a part of your complete flea control program for your home. Catching one female flea prevents 200 or more eggs from being laid: it's like catching 200 fleas at a time. The flea trap will reduce the number of fleas where ever it is used. Under certain conditions, it will also eliminate fleas from your home. Fleas on your pet are unlikely to leave and go to the trap. Remove fleas from your pet with a flea comb or flea soap. Make sure the flea trap is maintained for best results. Fleas and dust will reduce the stickiness of the pad. Replace the capture pad every few months as needed.
